2016 Vintage Trio

Vintage 2016 – warmer, with good fruit set and consistent ripening



2016 Crimson Pinot Noir

Bright youthful colour, vibrant fruit aromas of cherry and sour cherry with hints of dried herb, sweet tobacco and cranberry. With time in the glass the fruit opens up to sweet boysenberry. Bright entry with juicy acid that shapes the palate, blending and balancing with sweet tannins, finishes long and savoury. Youthful and fun drinking now but more time in bottle will see this integrate further. Drink now to 2028.



2016 Ata Rangi Pinot Noir

Deeper toned than the Crimson, with spices of cinnamon and clove, florals of Manuka flower and deeper notes of chocolate, fresh earth and wet iron. The palate is rich and bright, with great mid palate texture. Flavours of rosehip and red liquorice seep through finishing the wine with a youthful and delicious feel. Drink now to 2034.



2016 Ata Rangi McCrone Pinot Noir

Here the clay soils bring a sweet spice element and hints of black tea and forest floor. With a deeper wider spread of tannins on the palate than the elegant Ata Rangi. The McCrone is more open and expressive, like the hedonistic sibling. Very youthful and fun, with an exciting future. Drink now to 2034.
